

2021 Children of Members Scholarship Application

Applications must be submitted to Butler Rural Electric Cooperative's office by **Monday**, **February 1, 2021 at 5 p.m.** Applications must be received at the cooperative's office by February 1, not postmarked by this date. The scholarship deadline will not be extended for any reason, including school closings or delays due to weather.

Read the 2021 Children of Members Scholarship rules **before** completing this application. To qualify for the Children of Members Scholarship from Butler Rural Electric Cooperative, you must:

- Be the child or legal ward of a Butler Rural Electric Cooperative residential member living in a residence receiving electricity from Butler Rural Electric Cooperative at the time of the scholarship competition. Grandchildren and other relatives of cooperative members are not eligible to apply for this scholarship unless the applicant is the legal ward of the member.
- Be a graduating high school senior at the time you apply for the scholarship. College students and students who are beginning their college career but are not high school seniors are not eligible for this scholarship.
- Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or above on a 4.0 scale, or equivalent standing on a nontraditional scale. Weighted GPA will not be considered for this scholarship.

Transcripts and letters of recommendation must accompany the scholarship application at the time the application is submitted. If these are not submitted at the same time, the application will not be accepted.

Do not attach additional pages to the scholarship application. All information must be confined to this application. The only attachments permitted are transcripts and teacher recommendations. Other attachments, like resumes and additional pages, will not be considered.
